T: What is this?

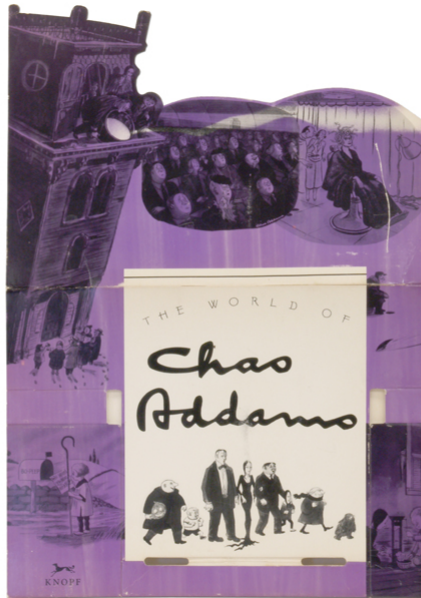
A: I'm just working on a children's story after being inspired by my children's book elist.
